This Articulation agreement facilitates transfer credit from York County Community College (YCCC) to the University of Maine at Fort Kent (UMFK) for the two majors listed below. The evaluation and transfer of earned college credits follows compliance with state and federal education policies and institutional and academic program accreditation standards pertaining to undergraduate academic transfer. Current students and graduates who have earned degrees from YCCC are eligible for credit evaluation under the terms of this agreement. To facilitate the transfer of credits, the student must submit an official transcript, from their graduating institution to UMFK (processing center).
