## Need help tracking down your required immunizations??

## Here are some suggestions

- 1) Contact your current PCP to determine what they already have on file. If they have 2 doses of MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) and a tetanus/diphtheria (Td/Tdap) shot within 10 years, simply have them fax that info to Enrollment Services at 207-641-0837.
- 2) If they have your tetanus/diphtheria shot on file, but do not have 2 doses on MMR, you can ask them to order you a titer test which is a simple blood drawn in the lab that will show if you are immune to MMR or not. We can accept titer tests showing you are immune in place of the actual vaccine.
- 3) If you have 2 doses of MMR, but your tetanus/diphtheria has expired, you will need to have your doctor give you an updated shot. Your doctor can tell you where to get your shot or they can put in an order at your local pharmacy, such as Rite Aid or CVS.
- 4) If your current doctor does not have your immunization records, and you cannot track down your previous doctor, you can check with your high school to see if they have anything on file. Sometimes they keep archived records of immunizations in their system.
- 5) If you are against immunizations for religious, philosophical or ethical reasons, you will have to submit a signed letter that states the specific reason that you do not wish to be immunized and return it to enrollment services. Please make sure to list your full name, date of birth and specific reason on the letter.
- 6) If you do not have a current PCP, you should establish one now to start the process, or you can contact your local immunization clinic or walk-in clinic for more information.
