**Transfer Articulation Agreement**

Montserrat College of Art and York County Community College, in recognition of a valuable academic experience, have created a transfer articulation agreement between Montserrat College of Art and York County Community College.

**OBJECTIVES:**

1. To encourage the transfer of qualified students from York County Community College to Montserrat College of Art.
2. To award academic credit for courses completed at York County Community College that meet the terms of the Associate of Applied Science in Graphic Design degree for application toward the requirements for the Bachelor of Fine Arts at Montserrat College of Art.
3. To provide effective and concise guidelines for students seeking to transfer to Montserrat College of Art. Students will have accurate and clear information regarding the transfer of their coursework and credits toward the Bachelor of Fine Arts at Montserrat College of Art.

**TERMS OF THE TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT:**

1. Montserrat College of Art guarantees the acceptance of students who completed an Associate of Applied Science in Graphic Design degree at York County Community College with an overall GPA of 2.5 or better to the Bachelor of Fine Arts program at Montserrat College of Art.
2. Montserrat College of Art guarantees the transfer of credit as stipulated in the attached Program of Studies. This agreement assumes the completion of the Associate Degree and completion of the courses listed on the attached Program of Studies. Montserrat College of Art requires that 50% of the coursework is completed in residence; a minimum total of 120 credits must be completed to earn the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree. Montserrat College of Art will accept no more than 60 credits in transfer from the two-year college (with a 36 credit cap on studio credits and a 24 credit cap on liberal art credits).
3. York County Community College students successfully transferring to Montserrat College of Art under the terms of this agreement will be guaranteed a two-year scholarship award. The Founder's Award will be an annual award in the amount of \$10,000 and based on full-time enrollment.
4. This Articulation Agreement is based upon the evaluation of course descriptions presented to Montserrat College of Art. Courses as listed in this agreement will transfer to Montserrat College of Art provide a grade of "C" or better has been earned.
5. This agreement shall remain in effect for a period of three years from the date listed below, with the provision that the terms specified herein will continue to apply to students admitted from York County Community College programs within one year of the expiration of the

agreement. Each institution agrees to provide timely notice to the other in the event of any modification to the curriculum that might affect the compatibility for admission and transfer of coursework. This agreement may be subject to change at either institution. Students admitted to York County Community College's programs prior to such notification shall be admitted to Montserrat College of Art on the basis of this agreement.




