Need Help Tracking Down your Immunizations?

Here are some Suggestions...

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### **What is required?**

- Two doses of MMR (or positive MMR Titer results)
  - Current Tetanus Vaccine (administered within ten years)
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- 1)** Contact your current doctor's office to determine what they already have on file. If they have **two doses of MMR** (Measles, Mumps, and Rubella) and a **Tetanus shot within 10 years**, simply have them **fax** that info to the Office of Admissions at **(207) 641-0837**.
- 2)** If they have your Tetanus shot on file, but do not have two doses on MMR, you can ask them to order you a **Titer test** which is a simple blood drawn in the lab that will show if you are immune to MMR or not. **We can accept Titer tests showing you are immune to MMR in place of the actual vaccines.** Please note that if the results do not show immunity, you will need to work with your doctor to have additional doses (depending on your individual results, you may need two doses of MMR, or one booster dose if your records show partial immunity).
- 3)** If you have two doses of MMR, but your Tetanus has expired, you will need to have your doctor give you an **updated Tetanus shot**. Your doctor administer the Tetanus shot or they can put in an order at your **local pharmacy**.
- 4)** If your current doctor does not have your immunization records, and you cannot track down your previous doctor, you can check with your **high school** to see if they have anything on file. Sometimes they keep archived records of immunizations in their system.
- 5)** If you do not have a current doctor, you should establish one now to start the process, or you can contact your local **immunization clinic** or **walk-in clinic** for more information.
