YCCC's Nursing is a COMPETITIVE PROGRAM with 32 SEATS available for FALL 2022.*

Acceptance into the Nursing program is on a competitive basis. Successful completion of the prerequisites does not guarantee acceptance into the Nursing program. Students who are working on their prerequisites will be placed in the Health Studies/Pre-Nursing program until they are ready to apply for the Nursing program. Upon acceptance into the Nursing program, students will receive an acceptance letter listing their start date and their nursing faculty advisor. The Fall 2022 semester has 32 seats available.

YCCC'S NURSING PROGRAM will prepare individuals to become registered nurses at the Associate Degree level. The curriculum will blend Nursing courses with general education courses to provide a sound theoretical base of nursing practice. Students will participate in clinical and classroom experiences during each of the four semesters in the program. Clinical experiences will be offered at hospitals and long-term care facilities located in York County. Upon successful completion of the program, graduates will be eligible to take the NCLEX Registered Nurse (RN) licensure examination.

PROGRAM LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Provide compassionate nursing care to patients, families, groups, populations, and communities from diverse backgrounds in a variety of settings; care that is age and culturally appropriate and based on a patient's preferences, values and educational needs.
- Communicate effectively and collaborate with diverse patients, families, groups, and members of the health care team to promote shared-decision making.
- Utilize information and patient care technology to manage care, support decision-making, minimize error while employing effective use of resources.
- Evaluate and integrate current evidence with clinical judgment to provide safe, quality care.
- Integrate professional behaviors and leadership skills in the provision of professional nursing care delivery.
- Use quality measures and indicators to evaluate patient outcomes and the effect of changes in the delivery of care.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS All YCCC students are required to show proof of vaccination.

- 2 doses of MMR Vaccine
- Tdap Vaccine (administered within 10 years)
- COVID-19 Vaccination and a Booster

***AP and/or CLEP credits will be accepted for College Composition and Introduction to Psychology. Math and Science prerequisites must be completed within seven years (January 2015 to May 2022.) TEAS test scores must be from within the past 4 years (May 2018 to May 2022.) All prerequisites for Fall 2022 applicants need to be completed and received by May 16, 2022**
