Student Ambassadors will be a part of the College's public information team. They will attend community and college events as well as serving as an informal advisor to the President of the College.

The ideal Presidential Student Ambassador will....

- Be currently enrolled in at least 6 credits at YCCC
- Maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA
- Demonstrate strong communication (written and verbal) and interpersonal skills
- Maintain professional appearance and demeanor
- Have the ability to serve for the whole academic year (September 2015-May 2016)
- Actively engage in the college and in the community
- Fill out FAFSA to be considered- does not need to qualify to be considered
 - Subject to criminal background check
 - Must complete sexual harassment training

What is the role of a Presidential Student Ambassador?

- Appearing with the President and other College administrators at community and college events (Ambassadors are not to consume alcohol during working hours)
- Acting as a host and/or tour guide for on-campus visitors
- Assisting the College to prepare for social events
- Providing confidential support in the Office of the President
