

## Registration for High School Students

**Dual Enrollment** is an early college experience for high school and home-schooled juniors and seniors who wish to experience a college classroom, explore career options, and earn both high school and college credit at the same time! Students may register for any courses if they meet the course prerequisites. Math, English and lab sciences will require the Accuplacer placement test or appropriate SAT or ACT scores.

**Concurrent Enrollment** involves taking college classes at your high school with college-approved high school teachers. Everything else is the same as dual enrollment above!

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a high school or home-schooled junior or senior.
- Have the necessary prerequisites for desired course(s), if any.
- Have permission from a parent and guidance counselor.
- Pay for associated tuition and fees (if any), and textbooks.

### Dual Enrollment Registration Process:

1. Discuss Dual Enrollment with your guidance counselor and parents. If interested, request a Dual Enrollment Application from your counselor. They are also available online.
2. Complete the Dual Enrollment Program Application and return to guidance counselor, or bring a completed application form to your appointment.
3. Whenever possible, make an appointment with Dual Enrollment Coordinator to review your application and complete course registration.
4. Make payment arrangements, if necessary.
5. ATTEND NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION.
6. Visit the College Bookstore to purchase textbooks.

**How much does it cost?** Each course at YCCC is \$94 per credit hour, plus college textbooks.

Currently, the Maine Department of Education will cover tuition for 6 credit hours per semester, and a total of 12 credits per academic year. Students are responsible for tuition or fees exceeding the 6 per semester, 12 per year limit.

Students are responsible for the cost of books and transportation.

**When do YCCC classes begin and end?** The college academic calendar is different from the high school calendar. Fall semester usually begins the day after Labor Day and ends mid-December. Spring semester usually begins the day after Martin Luther King Day and ends mid-May. Our spring vacation is in March. We do not have February and April break.
