YCCC is affordable. Our low tuition rates and full range of federal grants, loans and work-study, plus scholarship opportunities, give each student a chance at a quality education.

SCHOLARSHIPS

A great way to fund your education is through scholarships you may be eligible for. They can be MCCS or YCCC scholarships or outside scholarships. YCCC students are the beneficiaries of over \$42,000 in annual scholarship support provided through the York County Community College Foundation (YCCCF). Awarded twice annually students just need to complete a simple application that pairs qualified students with all YCCC Foundation scholarships for which they are eligible.






ACADEMIC ADVISORS

All matriculated (degree-seeking) students are assigned a faculty advisor through the academic department of their program of study at YCCC. In addition, students can always contact a staff advisor in the Student Affairs office. The advisor's primary role is to guide the student toward the accomplishment of his/her academic goals. Non-matriculated students should speak with a Student Affairs staff advisor to receive advising and/or to complete the matriculation process.

ACCOMMODATING DISABILITY

Our Office for Students with Disabilities is ADA recognized and takes a student-centered approach to documenting disability, and provides accommodations like assistive technology, audio books, quiet exam locations and more.

LIBRARY, RESEARCH AND REFERENCE

The YCCC library offers more than 14,000 library items including books, CDs, DVDs, videos, magazines, newspapers, and ebooks. YCCC is a member of Minerva, a statewide library consortium that gives YCCC students free access to more than 6 million library resources. Within the Library's Open Lab are over 30 computer workstations, each containing Microsoft Office and programming software, CAD and design applications, internet, and access to all of the Library's online research tools.
