This 18 hour per week position is designed to support students who may come to YCCC underprepared in mathematics. The coach becomes a bridge between the student, campus resources, and their instructors of math heavy courses. The coach will offer workshops both in person and virtually on 7 preselected common skills that students struggle with. This position is currently funded through May 2022 with anticipation of ongoing funding.

• Baccalaureate degree in mathematics or related field, knowledge of and proven experience in student tutoring and excellent interpersonal and presentation skills.

Desirable qualifications include:

 A Master's degree in mathematics or related field, recent experience in a community college, experience in student tutoring, knowledge of best-practices in academic learning communities, excellent writing and presentations skills, demonstrated ability to collaborate effectively with faculty, administrators and staff.
