For employees covered by the medical insurance offered by the College, if you have specific questions about your coverage, please log onto the MCCS portal <https://mymccs.me.edu/ics>. You can also call the member services phone number on the back of your medical insurance card.

SICK TIME

As previously announced by the MCCS, due to the circumstances, the issue of whether an employee has available sick or vacation time is secondary. Under these conditions and notwithstanding the otherwise applicable provisions of the collective bargaining agreements and system policy, you will not be obligated to use paid time off.

The CDC has recommended that employers not request doctors’ notes from employees who are ill in order to reduce strain on the health care system. Notwithstanding the collective bargaining agreements, and under these circumstances, we will not seek doctors’ notes of those who miss work because of illness.
